Dear Parents/Guardians

This is to provide you with financial information about the contributions and charges that will apply at Waroona District High School in 2024.

For secondary students the total amount of Voluntary Contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay has been contained to **\$235.00** per student. The secondary costing is the same amount which can be claimed through the Secondary Assistance Scheme for those parents/guardians who are eligible.

If your child chooses to do an additional specialised extra cost program in Years 7 – 10, these charges are **compulsory and must be paid**.

### **2024 SECONDARY ASSISTANCE SCHEME – PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

The Western Australian Department of Education provides an allowance to assist eligible families with secondary schooling costs. To be eligible for the allowance the parent/guardian must hold a Centrelink Health Care Card, Pensioner Concession Card or Veterans' Affairs card which lists the student as a dependant.

The allowance consists of two components:

**\$235 Educational Program Allowance** which is paid directly to the school. Any compulsory charges will be an additional cost to the parent/guardian, as this is not covered by the Secondary Assistance Scheme.

**\$115 Clothing Allowance** is paid directly to the parent/guardian for uniform expenses. Please bring in Bank Account details e.g. BSB and Bank Account Number.

Parents/guardians in receipt of the ABSTUDY School Allowance from the Department of Human Resources (Centrelink) are not eligible for the Secondary Assistance Scheme. However, they can apply for the ABSTUDY Supplement Allowance. Forms are available for completion in the Administration Office. To be eligible for the allowance the parent/guardian must hold a Centrelink or Veterans' Affairs card which lists the student as a dependant and present this when completing the form.

Applications for these allowances for students enrolled in Years 7 – 10, must be completed by the parent or guardian in **Term 1 prior to the closing date of Thursday 28 March 2024**. Applications cannot be processed after this date.

**SECONDARY ASSISTANCE CAN BE CLAIMED AT THE ADMINISTRATION OFFICE BETWEEN 8.00AM AND 3.30PM DAILY FROM WEDNESDAY, 31 January 2024.**

## SECONDARY CHARGES

The term charges refer to the provision of extra cost optional activities which are part of an education program which contributions do not cover. All of the following are optional and if no payment is received, an educational activity with a similar outcome will be provided to that student.

### Extra Cost Options

Recreation Centre Hire for special events	up to \$ 50.00 per student
Swimming Carnival & Trials	up to \$ 14.00 per student
TAFE Trade Taster/Trade Courses	up to \$300.00 per student
Year Book	up to \$ 30.00 per student
Bush Rangers Shirts	up to \$ 35.00 per student
Bush Rangers Camps	up to \$100.00 per student
Certificate Auspicing	up to \$220.00 per student
Visual Art Excursion	up to \$ 10.00 per student

**We stress that the following charges are set at the maximum amount. These charges are payable when the activity takes place.**

**Year 7 to 10 Country Week** up to \$500.00 per student

The actual cost may be less depending on subsidy by fundraising

**Year 7 to 10 STEM Camp** up to \$200.00 per student

**Year 7 to 10 Physical Education Activity**

There is usually 1 activity per year group up to \$ 40.00 per student

### Excursions

Year 10 Careers Activities – 2 trips per year up to \$ 55.00 per student

### Cultural Activities

There are usually 4-5 Cultural Activities each year. up to \$ 40.00 per student

Examples of Cultural Activities are events such as visiting Theatre Groups, Chaplain related activities, Musical Performances, Artists etc.

### Interschool Sports

This fee will cover the cost of the bus hire. up to \$ 50.00 per student

### Student Council Activities

There are various activities such as Free Dress Days and Sausage Sizzles that are run during the year. Other activities may run during the year. up to \$ 50.00 per student

### Year 10 Graduation

Graduation T-Shirts or Jackets are offered to students up to \$ 100.00 per student

Graduation Dinner up to \$ 50.00 per student

### School Dance

The School Dance is open to all Year 7-10 students up to \$ 30.00 per student

The cost of clothing is the parents' responsibility

### Other activities

Up to one extra activity per term, e.g. end of term incentive will occur at a maximum of cost of \$20.00 per activity. up to \$ 20.00 per student

Additional costs items such as camps, incursions and excursion may be incurred. Additional Design and Technology costs may be incurred for special, personal choice, projects.

### Whole School fundraising

up to \$50.00 per student

There are various activities such as Free Dress Days and Sausage Sizzles that are run during the year. All activities are voluntary to students.
