

Dear Parents/Guardians

This is to provide you with financial information about the contributions and charges that will apply at Waroona District High School in 2025.

For secondary students the total amount of Voluntary Contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay has been contained to **\$235.00** per student. The secondary costing is the same amount which can be claimed through the Secondary Assistance Scheme for those parents/guardians who are eligible.

If your child chooses to do an additional specialised extra cost program in Years 7 - 10, these charges are **compulsory and must be paid**.

2025 SECONDARY ASSISTANCE SCHEME – PUBLIC SCHOOLS

The Western Australian Department of Education provides an allowance to assist eligible families with secondary schooling costs. To be eligible for the allowance the parent/guardian must hold a Centrelink Health Care Card, Pensioner Concession Card or Veterans' Affairs card which lists the student as a dependant.

The allowance consists of two components:

ASPIRING

\$235 Educational Program Allowance which is paid directly to the school. Any compulsory charges will be an additional cost to the parent/guardian, as this is not covered by the Secondary Assistance Scheme.

\$300 Clothing Allowance is paid directly to the parent/guardian for uniform expenses. Please bring in Bank Account details e.g. BSB and Bank Account Number.

Parents/guardians in receipt of the ABSTUDY School Allowance from the Department of Human Resources (Centrelink) are not eligible for the Secondary Assistance Scheme. However, they can apply for the ABSTUDY Supplement Allowance. Forms are available for completion in the Administration Office. To be eligible for the allowance the parent/guardian must hold a Centrelink or Veterans' Affairs card which lists the student as a dependant and present this when completing the form.

Applications for these allowances for students enrolled in Years 7 – 10, must be completed by the parent or guardian in <u>Term 1 prior to the closing date of Friday 11 April 2025</u>. Applications cannot be processed after this date.

SECONDARY ASSISTANCE CAN BE CLAIMED AT THE ADMINISTRATION OFFICE BETWEEN 8.00AM AND 3.30PM DAILY FROM WEDNESDAY, 5 February 2025.

SECONDARY CHARGES

The term charges refer to the provision of extra cost optional activities which are part of an education program which contributions do not cover. All of the following are optional and if no payment is received, an educational activity with a similar outcome will be provided to that student.

Year 10 Graduation	
Graduation T-Shirts or Jackets are offered to students	up to \$ 100.00 per student

The cost of clothing is the parents' responsibility	
Other activities	up to \$ 20.00 per student
Up to one extra activity per term, e.g. end of term incentive will occur at	a maximum of cost of \$20.00
